Counselor's Corner

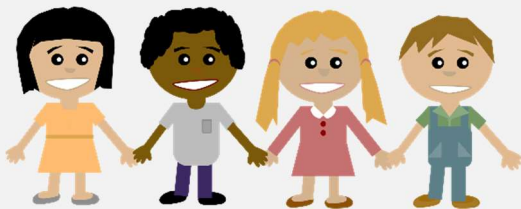
The characteristic for the month of
